

## **Common Opioids**

## **Prescription Opioids**

**Sufentanil (Dsuvia)** - This is about 5-10 times stronger than fentanyl, and 1,000 times more potent than morphine.

**Fentanyl**- This is about 50-200 times more potent than morphine.

Hydromorphone (Dilaudid) - This is about 5-10 times more potent than morphine.

**Oxymorphone (Opana)** - For reference this about 10 times more potent than morphine.

**Oxycodone (Roxicodone, Percocet, OxyContin)** - This is about 1.8 times more potent than morphine.

**Morphine (MS Contin, Oramorph)**- Morphine is one of the most well-studied opioids, which is why it is often used for comparing the strengths of other opioids.

Hydrocodone (Vicodin, Lortab) - This is about 0.59 less potent than morphine.

Tapentadol (Nucynta) - This is about 2-3 times less potent than morphine.

Tramadol (Ultram) - This is about 10% less potent than morphine.

Meperidine (Demerol) - This is about 10% less potent than morphine.

Codeine (Tuzistra XR) - This is about 14 times less potent than morphine.

## **Illicit Opioids:**

Carfentanil - This is about 10,000 times more potent than morphine.

Fentanyl - This is about 50 times more potent than morphine.

U-47700 (U4) - This is about 10 times more potent than morphine.

Heroin - This is about three times more potent than morphine.

## Medications used for OUD Treatment:

Buprenorphine (Suboxone) - This is about 40 times more potent than morphine.

Methadone (Methadose) - This is about 3 times more potent than morphine.
